I reported the abuse at the time to a senior Officer, Mr Harris. However, you requested that any future abuse should also be reported to you.

In accordance with your request, this letter is to inform you that I was abused again by Mr Rawlins this week (on Tuesday 20th January 2015) and I complained to Chief Officer Liburd at the time.

I look forward to hearing of your proposed remedy against the ongoing abuse of several prisoners by Mr Rawlins, which I note was the most prolific complaint by the assembled formal gathering of all prisoners on Christmas Eve, 24th December 2014.
